

Brampton Minor Lacrosse Rep Coaches Information Meeting 2010

1. Each team needs to pick a day and time for their regularly scheduled practice floor. Each team will be allocated 21 times on the floor (including games and practices). If you can not use your floortime please advise me ASAP – so that I may offer it to another team. House League is finished mid July – so after that there is usually lots of floortime available. The cost of a floor is \$65.00 / hour.
2. Each team is expected to provide me with a copy of their team budget via email and hard copy by the time of your tryouts.
3. All rep fees are due in by June 15/10 no Exceptions as one cheque from each team.
4. Most zone games will start the first full week in May. The Tykes, PeeWees and Midgets will be playing the majority of their games on Wednesday nights and the Novices, Bantams and Intermediates will be playing the majority of their games on Thursday nights, with some over flow on Tuesday nights. This is in a state of flux as there are more and more teams at each level from the centers in our zone
5. We also require a final budget by September 1st/10 for the season. This is in our constitution to be provided.
6. I would like a list of all tournaments you are entering before going to first tournament. (This should be included with your preseason budget). I will also be looking for you to forward to me the results of the tournament for our records. I.e.: scores and final placing. This is now mandatory so I can assist with getting our teams ranked correctly for the provincials.
7. I would like to see all games and tournaments in the newspaper regardless of the results win, lose or draw. Easy way to do this is to get a parent who is reliable to look after this as I didn't see a lot of this happen last year. I have attached a form for this to happen just follow the directions on this form.

We require your home game sheets to be sent into the zone. This year the Zone is re-introducing their fines for any missing game sheets. The fine that the BMLA gets charged will be passed on to the offending team. All home game sheets need to be mailed to:

9. We will require each team to send either a parent rep or manager to our McCauley tournament meeting in late May to find out duties and responsibilities to run the McCauley tournament. All the #1 teams will be playing in the tournament. All the #2 Teams are expected to assist with running this tournament by supplying at least 5 representatives to perform various functions – if you do so then \$400.00 will be reduced from your rep bill. If your team does not supply a minimum of 5 individuals who can do the hours allocated to your team then you do not receive any reduction on your rep bill.
10. We will again be doing bench staff evaluations. We will be giving the link to the rep players to help the BMLA assess the quality of the coaching staff we put in place. This form will be available online and I will provide a link once it is ready. I expect the link to be given out to all parents.
11. See Attached: OLA Team lists to be filled out and returned to me after TRYOUTS and confirmed again no later than June 1/10. THIS FORM TO BE COMPLETE IN ALL FIELDS or you run the risk of your team not going to provincials.
12. Team ratings – team ratings for provincial is done in mid June you must have 10 games played and I must have your opinion of your team rating and your supporting evidence. The goal is to reach A/B at all levels in the near future.
13. With regards to any Game Suspensions or Tournament Fines – if anyone (bench or player) receives a fine or suspension at any time you need to notify me immediately. Should you get fined at a tournament – DO NOT PAY THERE – the OLA will bill the BMLA for this. Any fine amounts will be added to your final rep bill. If the fines occur after the bill has been paid then you must come to me with the money in hand right after the tournament.
